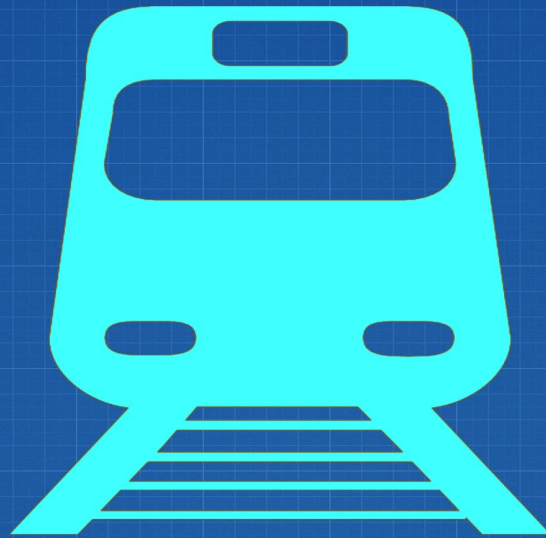

The FamilyLines Regular.ttf lettering font



This is a free font and cannot be sold or be part of a commercial product.

This font was created using references from the Internet. It is based on various sources related to Google searches.

This lettering tries to capture the 1970's to 1980's L&N with SCL Merger logos as well as Family Lines prior to formation of CSX with the Chessie System, SCL and Early SAL.

Disclaimer

This ttf font is a best effort attempt at recreating a vector based image suite related to Engine and Freight. Some variances exist in real life and therefore there may be some discrepancies between what is supplied here and actual prototype references.

Font Usage

Installation

The file is distributed as part of a ZIP file that includes this document as well as the font itself and other related documentation.

The files need to be UNZIPPED from the distribution file into a temporary work area, like **C:\TEMP**. (I'll assume that you used **c:\temp** from here on...)

You can often just double-click the TTF file and the system will provide an install option.

Now you can install the font from the Windows **CONTROL PANEL**.

Your system may be different, but for Windows 7, you would select **START** → **Settings** → **Control Panel** → **FONTS** → **FILE** [pull down] → **INSTALL NEW FONT**

From here you would select your new file **C:\temp\FamilyLines Regular.ttf**

That's it, the font is installed.

As with all other TTF fonts on your system, the FamilyLines Regular.ttf file enclosed within the ZIP file belongs in the **FONTS** folder of your windows operating system. This is the only way this file would be useful.

Result	Key	Description
	?	Seaboard System - Multi Color (Black) Background
	.(period)	Seaboard System - Multi Color (White)
	/	Seaboard System - Multi Color (Red)

Choose a large font size (~ 144 or so)

- Step 1 - Use ? with Black
- Step 2 - Use . (Period Key) with White
- Step 3 - Use / (Forward Slash) with Red for Heart

Done... Multi-color Logo is the result.
